YOU are the union. Please get more involved by lending your talents and working on a subcommittee for Chapter 24, serve as an officer, delegate, steward or attend meetings to learn what is going on!

Our chapter typically meets the 2nd Thursday of the month at 12:05 PM on the 5th floor of 79 Elm Street. There are many subcommittees that work to make our workplace better for members. Chapter 24 subcommittees include nominations, labor-management, social activities, by-laws and leadership. Members also serve on P-4 Council committees such as Contract Negotiations, Health & Safety and Good & Welfare. Contact a Chapter 24 Officer or Steward to see how you can make a difference.

Each chapter of CSEA elects one P-4 Council delegate for every 20 members. Delegates are expected to attend the regularly scheduled council meeting that occurs on the first Thursday of every month. Chapter 24's delegates represent our Chapter 24 members and bring forth member ideas and viewpoints to the P-4 Council. P-4 Council meetings are open to all chapter members but only delegates can vote on matters before the Council. Chapter 24 members elect P-4 Council delegates bi-annually at the May Chapter 24 meeting. At this meeting P-4 "alternate" delegates are also elected. If a P-4 Council delegate cannot attend a meeting an alternate delegate will be seated and have all authority allowed to a regular delegate.

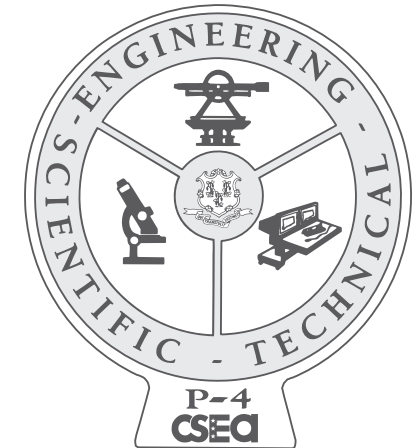

CSEA/SEIU Local 2001 represents more than 22,000 active public sector workers and retirees. Our organization began as the labor and political advocacy organization for Connecticut state employees in 1941. Our members work in a wide variety of state and local agencies that affect all of our daily lives, such as education, health and welfare, social services, public safety, criminal justice, transportation, environmental health, corrections, and services for the disabled.

Our Bargaining Unit and Chapter 24

Chapter 24 is part of the P-4 bargaining unit of CSEA. The P-4 bargaining unit represents engineering, scientific, and technical employees in the State of Connecticut. We are made up of engineers, analysts, scientists, information technology professionals and others who have professional job classifications. There are approximately 2,500 P-4 members, and nearly 600 are members of Chapter 24.

P-4 members work in many agencies including the Departments of Health, Military, Transportation, Public Safety, Public Works, Environmental Protection, Information Technology, Mental Health Services, Agriculture, Labor, and the Agricultural Experiment Station; just to name a few.

Chapter 24 members work at the Departments of Environmental Protection, Agriculture, Health and the Military. Most of our members work in various functions to protect the natural resources of the state. Our chapter is one of 19 chapters that make up the P-4 Engineering, Scientific and Technical Council.

Your Union Rights and Responsibilities

You Have the Right to:

- Have opinions heard and respected, to be informed of union activity, to be educated in union values and union skills;
- Choose the leaders of the union in a fair and democratic manner;
- A full accounting of union dues and the proper stewardship over union resources;
- Participate in the union's bargaining efforts and to approve union contracts; and
- Have members' concerns resolved in a fair and expeditious manner.

You Have the Responsibility to:

- Help build a strong and more effective labor movement, to support the organizing of unorganized workers, to help build a political voice for working people, and to stand up for one's co-workers and all workers;
- Be informed on how our union works and to participate in its activities;
- Contribute to the support of the union;
- Treat all workers and members fairly; and
- Offer constructive criticism of the union.
